

Reopening Guidelines

Before you leave your house:

NO FEVER (no fever reducing medication)

No excessive coughing or sneezing (use your judgment with allergies)

Go over health rules with your child about covering face when coughing or sneezing

Wash hands or use sanitizer.

In the car, please talk to your little ones about the fact that you will be outside in the car waiting and they are now big girls and can dance without you in the lobby. I will leave the blinds open so if they need reassurance, they can come and look out the window and wave.

Arriving at the studio:

STAY IN YOUR CAR until the prior class IS outside and in the pick-up line.

I know we are all excited to see each other, but **NO HUGGING** please.

Someone will come outside and let you know it is time to bring the next class in.

ALL STUDENTS: Go directly to your dance room

PARENT/GUARDIANS: For younger students, please **walk them to the door and let them in.**

PARENT/GUARDIANS: If coming into the lobby, **please wear a mask.**

Tuition for May is ½ month

Classroom Hygiene and new rules:

Our faculty has worked out a system for their dance bags so students do not bunch up in one area

Changing classrooms with no congestion in the hallway or lobby

Teachers will wash hands in between each class

Teachers will wear a mask the first 2 weeks

Dance rooms and bathroom will be sanitized between classes.

Leaving the studio:

Classes will end 5 minutes early to allow for between-class sanitizing

Parent volunteer will line-up students outside for the pick-up line

Car line pick-up:

Parent/Guardian: Please have a sign in your front car window with your child's

First and last name

Walk –up pick-up:

Parent/Guardian: Please speak with the line leader to pick up your child

We're not sure with method will work best, so we'll try both

Parents of older students that are here for longer times need to return at least 10 minutes before they are finished with their last class and be in the parking lot ready to pick them up and not have them in the lobby waiting for you.

*****WE NEED YOUR HELP*****

As great as they are, our faculty can't be in two places at once. **We need parent volunteers (2 per class) to help** with the pick-up lines and sanitizing the dance and bathrooms. We can rotate as needed to get this to work as best we can. If the initial approach doesn't work, we will try something different.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

The biggest problem we have with entering and exiting the studio involves getting their dance shoes on or off.... I usually hear " Will you please hurry up and change your shoes so we can leave."

This was suggested and I really like this.....

DANCE TRAVEL SHOES (DTS)

Your child needs to have a dance bag with only her shoes in it and not to just carry them in.

Have a pair of house slippers or sandals in a size large enough to fit with dance shoes already on.

This allows your child to be able to have the dance shoes already on when they enter the studio and just slip off their DTS and be ready to go. When they are finished with class, they can slip on their DTS without taking off their dance shoes and they are ready for home. This will help make class changes and the pick-up line more efficient.

MASKS: There are pros and cons in trying to dance while wearing a mask. I would prefer that students NOT wear a mask.

Hand sanitizer will be available for everyone coming in and out

Please do not drop off your child early
